

**CALL FOR 10 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE

1. Premise

2. Beneficiaries and Requirements

To apply for scholarships you must be a student who has been admitted to the course and has met all the following requirements:

- Works as local staff in developing countries of Africa and South Est Asia**
or has volunteered consistently and continuously in emergency or international development fields, if not yet employed
- Has received a favourable opinion from the interviewer at the time of orientation and admission interview;
- Has a University Degree
- Has a situation of objective and demonstrable difficulty and economic instability;
- Has presented an adequate motivation for the request

3. Scholarship

The Social Change School will provide scholarships worth € 1000 up to € 2.000.

The Master Edition this announcement refers to is starting in **December 2018**.

The request for the scholarship will be made only by the students who have passed the Potential Evaluation and Admission interview for the Master with the competent Advisers.

4. Submission of Applications

Applicants must pass the Admission Interview for the Master with the competent Advisers – non-binding enrolment.

The Commission's decision will be final.

5. Documentation

The application must be accompanied by the following documentation:

- a) Economic status attestation
- b) A letter of reference from a responsible of the present or a past organization
- c) Curriculum Vitae and Degree /Master Certificate
- d) Motivation Letter;

6. Selection Criteria

For the selection of the candidate, the following criteria are respected:

- An excellent CV and an appropriate Motivation Letter
- Good references
- Opinion of Advisers after the Admission Interview
- Unemployment or job insecurity
- Consistent and continuous commitment in volunteering in emergency or international development fields, if not yet employed.

7. Deadlines for submission of Scholarship applications

Applications for the scholarship must be submitted to the Social Change School within the following deadlines:

- **First Deadline:** By the 31st of August 2018, candidates must submit the request for scholarship, communicating the name of the assignee before the 3th September 2018.
- **Second Deadline:** By the 31st of October 2018, candidates must submit the request for scholarship, communicating the name of the assignee before the 5th of November 2018.
- **Third Deadline:** By the 30th of November 2018, candidates must submit the request for scholarship, communicating the name of the assignee before the 3th December 2018.

8. Terms for enrolment in the Master of Social Change School. Submission of Applications for Scholarships

Registration must be formalized, in compliance with the procedure established by the Social Change School, no later than one week after being awarded the fellowship.

9. Starting Date

The beginning of the courses will take place with access to the platform scheduled for **December 2018**.

10. Cost

The amount of the scholarships (1,000 or 2,000 Euros) will be deducted from the total cost of the Master. Scholarships cannot be combined with discounts.

11. Payment

Payment can be made in one or **2 instalments** without interest to be paid during the first 6 month.

If you want to be considered for this option you need to pay the enrollment fee of € 1000 in advance.

13. Data Processing

The personal information provided with the above application will be processed in compliance with the European requirements. Such data will be processed exclusively for the purposes set out in this announcement. Social Change School is the owner and can manage the personal data above in its various joint function.

14. Payment Method

The payment of the amounts provided by the scholarship will be made by the School for Social Change integrating it into the Beneficiary's tuition costs.
